

## P R E F A C E

This volume contains some reviews and original research contributions, which are related to the **10th Mathematical Physics Meeting: School and Conference on Modern Mathematical Physics**, organized by the Institute of Physics, Belgrade (Serbia), September 9–14, 2019. The programme of this meeting was mainly oriented towards some recent developments in gravity and cosmology, string and quantum field theory, and some relevant mathematical methods.
